Temiskaming Shores is a vibrant city with endless opportunities nestled in the heart of Northeastern Ontario. Created by the amalgamation of the former Town of New Liskeard, the former Town of Haileybury, and the former Township of Dymond in 2004, the City of Temiskaming Shores is commonly known for its 'friendly northern attitude' and its beautiful surrounding environment. The City is home to many scenic landscapes, a rich heritage, educational, social and health care services and a multicultural population.

The City is situated on the border of the Province of Quebec, on the shores of Lake Temiskaming. It offers beautiful lakefront properties just a short distance from the downtown core. Shorter commute times allow more time to enjoy the leisure activities and inviting parkland located in the area.

The residents of Temiskaming Shores are engaged in the active development of the community. The volunteer sector is evident of the hours of support given to host successful annual events and initiatives. We are continuously holding a wide range of special

events, activities and festivals that complement the natural attractions of the area, creating a vibrant and active place to live.

The City of Temiskaming Shores is the commercial hub of a large agricultural, forestry and mining region. Nous retrouvons une présence française au Témiskaming dès les années 1670 avec l'établissement d'un poste de traite de fourrures à l'embouchure des rivières Montréal et Matabitchuan sur une île du lac Témiscamingue. Dès le début de l'ouverture du territoire, les francophones sont venus de partout en Amérique pour s'installer en grande partie sur les riches terres agricoles.

La francophonie témiskamienne s'est créée des institutions à son image. D'abord, nous retrouvons des paroisses catholiques avec ses associations telles que les Chevaliers de Colomb et les Filles d'Isabelle; trois écoles catholiques élémentaires, une école publique, une école secondaire catholique, un Centre d'éducation des adultes et un Centre d'apprentissage. La région compte aussi sur une caisse populaire avec ses trois succursales (Earlton, New Liskeard et Haileybury), des Clubs de services tels que le Richelieu Timiskaming, les Lions d'Earlton, deux chapitres de l'Union culturelle des Franco-Ontariennes (Earlton et New Liskeard); et trois clubs de l'âge d'or (d'Earlton, Sourire de New Liskeard et Club Joyeux de Haileybury). Nous retrouvons aussi une fondation, la Fondation communautaire du Témiskaming, l'Association de canot-camping du lac Témiscamingue et le Concours de labour du Témiskaming. L'Association canadienne-française de l'Ontario (ACFO), région Témiskaming, œuvre en région depuis 1972. Elle a aidé à mettre sur pied, le Centre culturel ARTEM, le Centre de santé communautaire du Témiskaming, le campus du Témiskaming du Collège Boréal et le Festival des Folies Franco-Fun. On retrouve aussi plusieurs francophones à la tête d'entreprises de la région.

Temiskaming Shores is situated on traditional Algonquin/Ojibwe territory. The surrounding First Nations communities include: Matachewan First Nation, Beaver House First Nation, Temagami First Nation and Timiskaming First Nation. The majority of the indigenous population in the area are of Algonquin and Ojibwe tribes.

Temiskaming Native Women's Support Group (TNWSG)

Keepers of the Circle Aboriginal Family Learning Centre is located at 121 Scott Street in Temiskaming Shores. It is a place that indigenous and non-indigenous people can gather. We offer various programs such as: licensed child care services, healthy lifestyle education, prenatal nutrition, referrals to community services and family support services for children and families. We also offer cultural workshops such as making drums, dream catchers, moss bags and moccasins. Programming within our centres includes visits from Elders who share Anishnawbe ways through storytelling, drumming, art and practicing the language. Some traditions that we share regularly are community feasts, drumming circles and full moon ceremonies. Our staff is always happy to help individuals learn more about the indigenous culture. 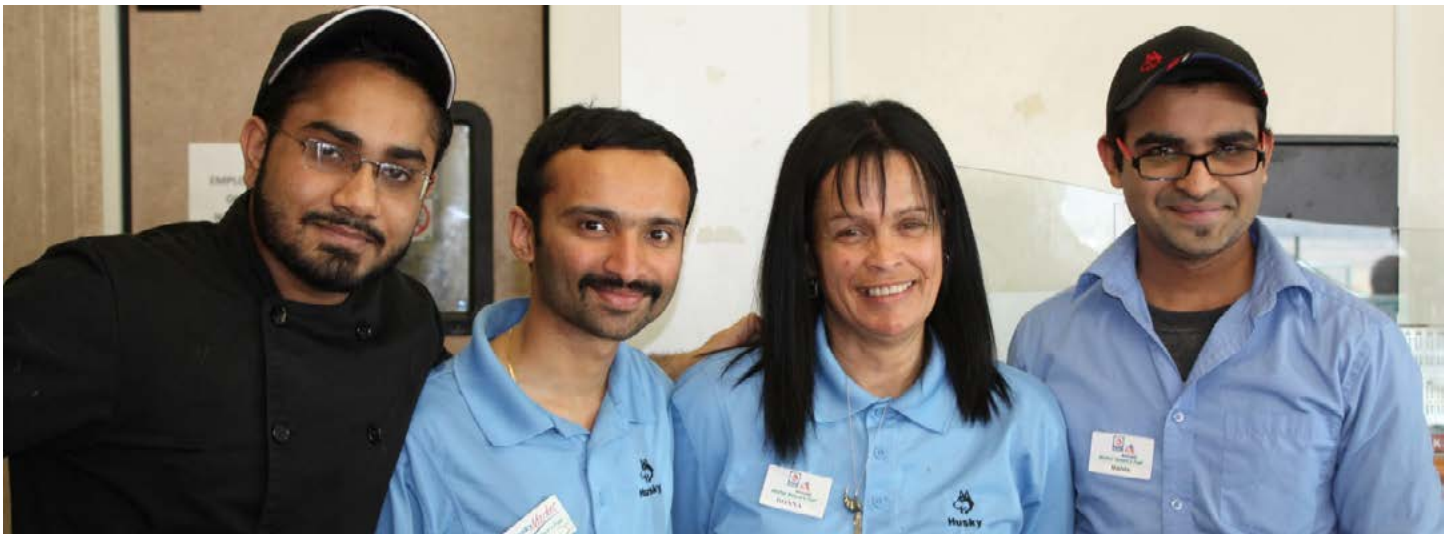

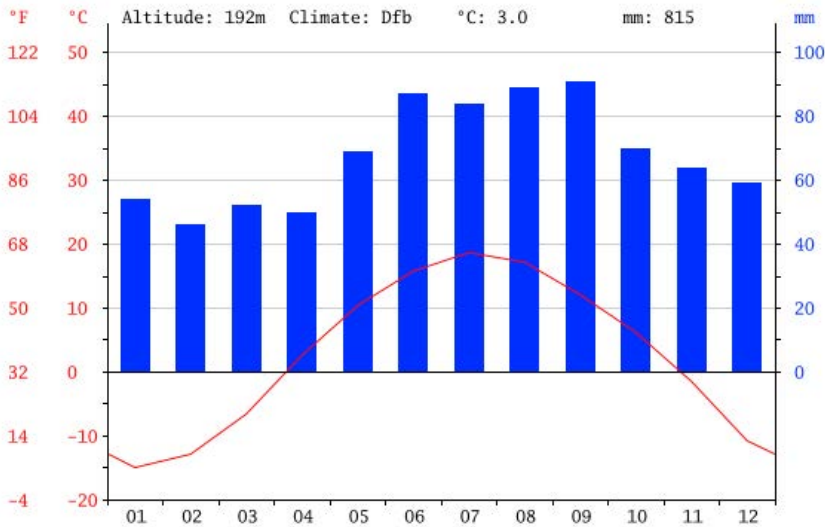

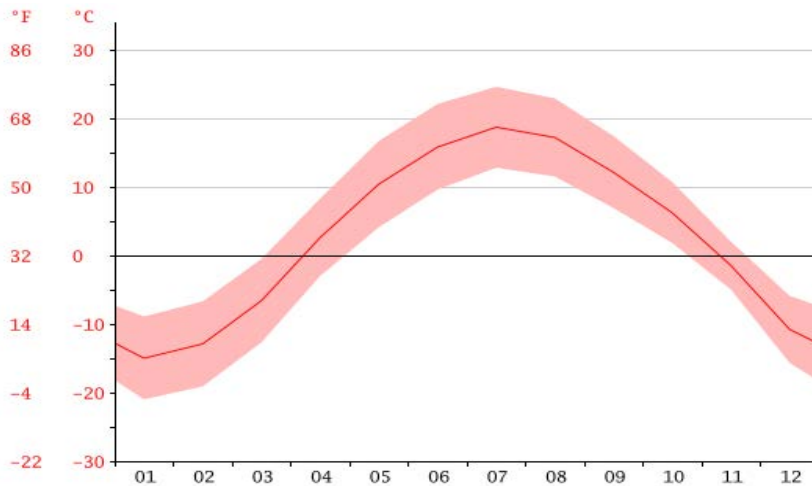
Climate

Haileybury

Enjoy beautiful Lake Temiskaming. The Haileybury beach is approximately 100 meters square and is supervised during the summer months. It features a 150-foot waterslide, a water fountain, and a water umbrella to be enjoyed by children and adults alike.

The Haileybury Marina is a full service marina on the west side of Lake Temiskaming at the mouth of the Wabi Bay. This Marina has 176 slips, 92 with water and hydro hook-up and there is a free boat launch.



New Liskeard

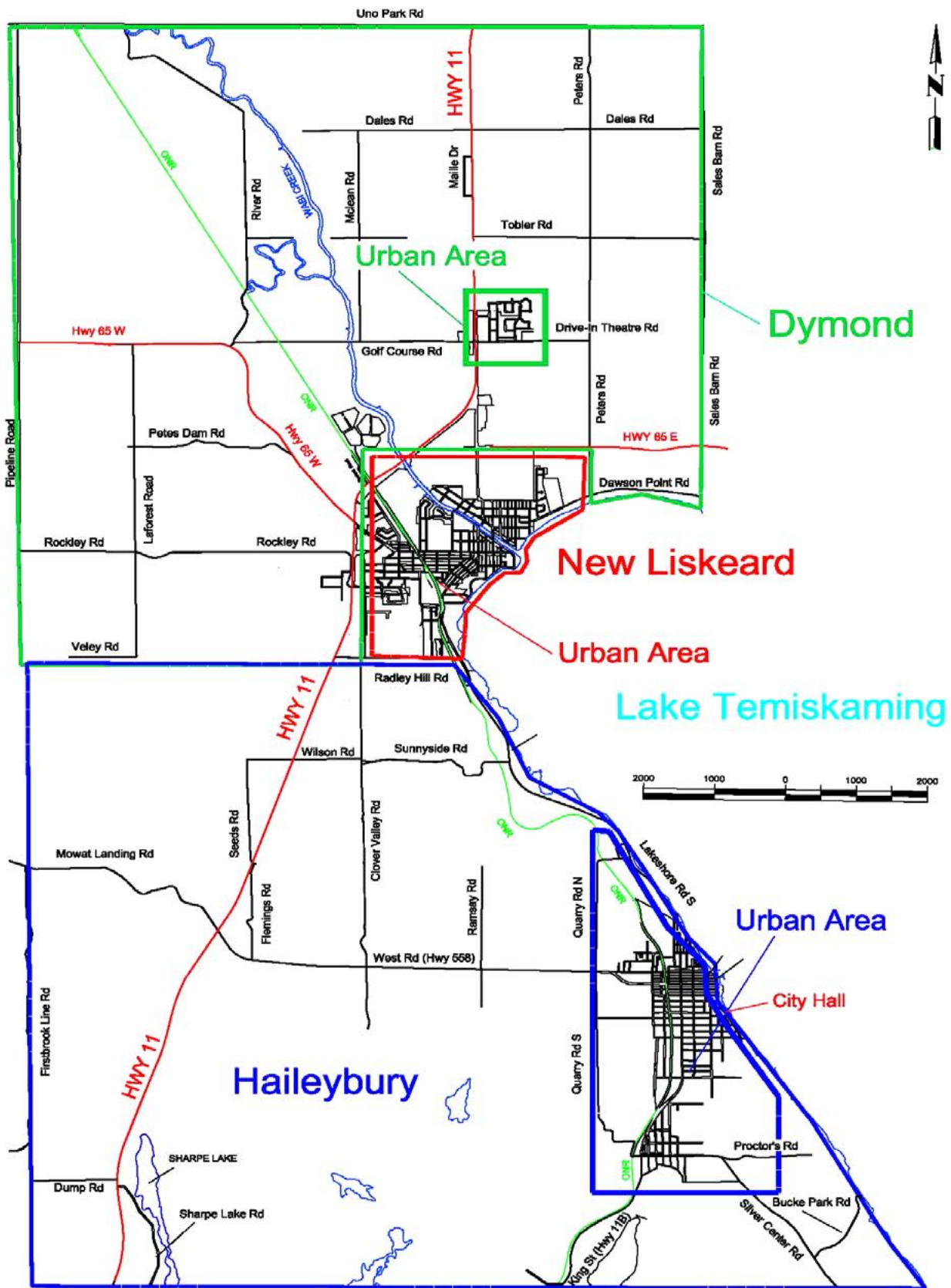

A Brief History:



John Armstrong

The first European settlers to arrive in the New Liskeard area, in 1891, were William Murray and Irvin Heard. John Armstrong, Crown Lands Agent and later on New Liskeard's first mayor, arrived some years later. Settlers took advantage of the rich soil in the area and New Liskeard became a key agricultural center in the North. Dymond was incorporated in 1901; New Liskeard, in 1903.

In 1889, Charles Cobbold Farr left his employment with the Hudson Bay Company and moved his family to a clearing along the shore of Lake Temiskaming known as Humphrey's Depot. This spot was also known by its Algonkian name, Matabanick, an ancient native portage whose name roughly translates "place where the trail ends".

C.C. Farr's dream was to establish a community, which he would name Haileybury after the school he attended in England. In 1893 he wrote a pamphlet entitled "The Lake Temiscamingue District" which he distributed in an effort to encourage settlement. Haileybury's early growth was slow, but with the advent of the railway, the discovery of silver in 1903, and the establishment of the Cobalt Mining Camp, Haileybury experienced a population explosion. Haileybury and the Village of North Cobalt (located in Bucke Township) became a "bedroom" community for many of the miners, prospectors, and promoters who worked in Cobalt. Haileybury's Lakeshore Road came to be known as Millionaire's Row in reference to the many mine owners, managers and other professionals who built their majestic homes along Lake Temiskaming's shore.

By 1904 the Town was incorporated and in 1912 Haileybury was declared the Judicial Seat for the District of Temiskaming.

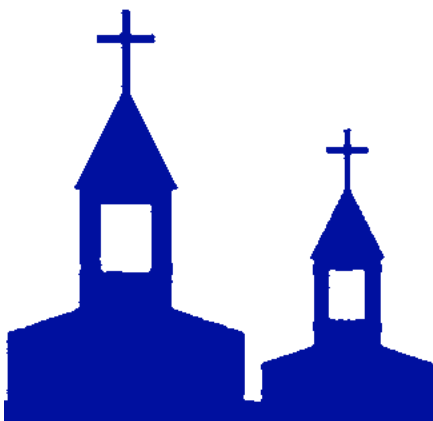
